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ADDITIONAL DEGREE COMPLETION REQUIREMENTS

1. **Minimum Unit Requirement:** Complete a minimum of 60 transferable units. Please note that additional units may be required to meet this minimum based upon courses selected to fulfill CSU-GE Breadth Pattern or the IGETC Pattern.

Choose either option for the General Education Core:

- CSU G.E. Breadth (39-41 units)- **Including Golden Four** (A3- critical thinking, A1- communication, A2- English composition, and B4- quantitative reasoning w/a minimum grade of “C”)
- IGETC – (34-41 UNITS) –All courses must be completed with a “C” grade or higher.
(IGETC GE is recommended to avoid going over 60 transfer units)

2. **Double-Counting of Units:** SB1440 Regulations allow for double-counting of major requirements towards CSU-GE Breadth or IGETC patterns. **0** units of the Music for Transfer Degree coursework can be applied to the CSU-GE Breadth or IGETC patterns.

3. **Minimum grade and GPA requirements:** Maintain an overall grade point average (GPA) of 2.0 (“C” average) in all CSU-transferable coursework. For the major, complete each course with a grade of “C” or better. A “P” (Pass) grade is not an acceptable grade for courses in the major.

Please note: Student’s GPA may need to be significantly higher for impacted campuses and impacted programs/majors.

4. **Residences for the Degree:** Complete at least 12 units in residence at LAHC.

5. **Degree Application:** Make an appointment with a counselor to complete, sign, and submit your petition for graduation to the Admissions and Records Office during your final semester of coursework. The graduation petition forms are available in the Counseling Office. **Please note:** a counselor’s signature is required on the graduation petition. Refer to the Schedule of Classes: <http://www.lahc.edu/classes/schedules.html> (front page) to view the actual graduation petition deadline for each semester.

Additional suggested coursework:

Music Majors are required to pass piano proficiency examinations before earning degrees at most CSU universities. Although it is not required for the AA-T, the LAHC Music Department strongly recommends that students attain piano proficiency at or above the level of MUS 324 – Elementary Piano IV, before they transfer. Four semesters of MUS 180 - Applied Music Laboratory is also strongly recommended for Instrumental or Vocal performance majors. The AAT-Guarantees acceptance into programs leading toward a Bachelor of Arts in Music degree rather than Bachelor of Music degree programs at CSU universities. Students wishing to transfer into Bachelor of Music programs may need additional lower division coursework and may need to pass auditions and additional placement tests at the transfer institutions.
