Subject: 2016-17 Comprehensive Program Review for CTE Workshop

A Comprehensive Program Review (CPR) workshop session especially designed for Career Technical Education (CTE) programs was held by the Office of Institutional Effectiveness on Friday, December 9, 2016, in SSC 203 from 9 AM – 12 PM.

The purpose of the session was to introduce the various CPR for CTE modules and facilitate the process of completing the 2016-17 Comprehensive Program Review obligations.

All CTE areas were invited. Attendance came from six academic divisions: Business, Counseling, Health Sciences, Humanities and Fine Arts, Mathematics & Technology, and Science, Family & Consumer Studies. One student services unit was also in participated: Special Programs and Services. The CPR timeline and process were reviewed, modules applicable to CTE programs were introduced, module components and other resources were discussed, and time to create and/or modify modules was provided to participants.
